## Uncompromised Faith

*Matthew 4:8-10 "Worship the Lord your God, and serve only him."*



Jesus was not crucified because He was gentle or agreeable. He was crucified because He was uncompromising. Standing before Pilate, Jesus refused to bow to the power of Rome or the authority of the emperor. He would not deny who He was or reshape His message to survive. When Jesus said, "My kingdom is not from this world," He made clear that His allegiance was not to empire, politics, or power – but to God alone. That refusal led Him to the cross.

This still matters today. We live in a world that pressures us to place our hope in leaders, systems, and policies. Subtly, we are tempted to soften our faith to fit cultural expectations or remain silent to avoid discomfort. Jesus reminds us that God's kingdom does not rise or fall with governments. Our ultimate loyalty belongs to Christ.

Following Jesus may place us out of step with the world, but the cross reminds us that faithfulness – not power – is where God's true work is revealed.

### CHRISTMAS JOY OFFERING 2025

Thank you for your donations to the Christmas Joy Offering.

Last year:

- Donations were used to provide critical financial support and grants for current and retired Presbyterian church workers in their time of need.
- Income supplements from the Board of Pensions helped over 300 households, assisting retired church workers and surviving spouses with the means to provide for themselves.
- Housing supplements from the BOP helped more than 250 households remain in their homes, afford assisted living, or long-term care.
- Emergency Assistance Grants from the BOP helped more than 109 households facing times of great financial need or uncertainty due to unforeseen circumstances.
- Donations were used to provide education and leadership development skills at Presbyterian-related schools and colleges equipping communities of color. Many of these students were the first in their families to enroll in higher education.

Because we all gave a little, it really added up to a lot!

### MAD HATTERS 2025 RECAP

In 2019 Kathy Cumpston started the group with 4 members. They made 323 hats and 36 blankets.

In 2025 they are up to 12 ladies that are hat making machines!

They made 2,124 hats! Not only did they make hats, but they also made 94 blankets and 118 bears! They also dressed 218 Barbie dolls and donated 331 Match Box cars! The items were distributed to 19 schools, non-profit organizations, a hospital and the Firestone Park Blessing Box and Day Care.

The Hatter's would like to thank the members of both Allenside and FP for the donations of yarn, fleece, felt, material, monetary donations and for the ACME cash back receipts. There are boxes in the rear of both sanctuaries to place your receipts. Receipt collection ends on February 15. Without the supplies, none of this would be possible.
